The University of New Haven values its relationships with the Greater New Haven community. Service is one way in which we are able to give back.

The President's Public Service Fellowship places 8-10 highly qualified undergraduate students in a nonprofit or public service work environment for 11 weeks during the summer to share their time and talents. Fellows spend time working in their placements, but also spend time as a group, attending educational, social, and service activities in West Haven and New Haven.

The Fellowship provides students valuable work experience and an elevated awareness of the needs in their community; serves to foster the relationships with the Greater New Haven community; and showcases what the University has to offer through student outreach. By the end of the summer, Fellows gain valuable experience, a new appreciation for service, and notable growth in the competency areas of leadership, resilience, teamwork, communication, global and cultural awareness, and critical thinking.
